## *Disney's The Lion King Jr* **THEATRE INFORMATION & SCHEDULE**

Dear Parents,

Your children's performances are just around the corner and we are so excited to share it with all of you. Here are a few very important items regarding the performances and the venue that you should take note of:

- Students are required to be at the theatre by 5:45 p.m. on the evening of their performance. They will meet their classroom teacher at the Stage Door.
- Please note that **the school is NOT organizing transportation** for the performances and parents are expected to arrange transportation for their children to and from the venue. If you are having trouble arranging transportation to the theatre, or have space in your car and are able to take other students and their family members, please indicate so on the form sent home separately.
- Students should arrive in their performance clothing: beige t-shirt, black pants, black shoes.
- The musical is expected to run until 7:40 p.m. Student pickup will be from the Stage Door in five-minute, two-division shifts starting 5 minutes after the end of the performance. Please note the following scheduling times for when to pick up your child:

### **Tuesday, February 27**

- Odd numbered Divisions perform (i.e., Divisions 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17)
- Theatre Doors open at 5:30 p.m. (concession available)
- Students must be dropped off at the Stage Door by 5:45 p.m.
- Seating Doors open at 6:00 p.m.
- Performance begins promptly at 6:30 p.m.
- Performance ends at 7:40 p.m. (expected)
- **Student pickup from Stage Door (5 minutes after end of performance): Div. 15/17 at 7:45 p.m., Div. 11/13 at 7:50 p.m., Div. 7/9 at 7:55 p.m. Div. 1/3/5 at 8:00 p.m.**

### **Wednesday, February 28**

- Even numbered Divisions perform (i.e., Divisions 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16)
- Theatre Doors open at 5:30 p.m. (concession available)
- Students must be dropped off at the Stage Door by 5:45 p.m.
- Seating Doors open at 6:00 p.m.
- Performance begins promptly at 6:30 p.m.
- Performance ends at 7:40 p.m. (expected)
- **Student pickup from Stage Door (5 minutes after end of performance): Div. 14/16 at 7:45 p.m., Div. 10/12 at 7:50 p.m., Div. 6/8 at 7:55 p.m. Div. 2/4 at 8:00 p.m.**

## CENTENNIAL THEATRE FAQ

*Where is Centennial Theatre?*

It is located at 2300 Lonsdale Avenue, North Vancouver. Please see map below.



*How many people does the theatre seat?*

Approximately 650 at capacity. Everyone over the age of two is required to purchase a ticket. Children younger than two can sit on their parent's lap or purchase a ticket for their own seat.

*What time does the show start?*

The lobby doors open at 5:30 p.m. and the seating area will open at 6:00 p.m. The show will start at 6:30 p.m. Students are required to arrive by 5:45 p.m. at the Stage Door.

*What are the in-and-out privileges?*

You may leave and enter the theatre with a valid ticket stub.

*Is there late admittance to the theatre after the performance has started?*

Yes, late arrivals will be admitted but will have to wait to be ushered in at an appropriate moment during the performance. We recommend that families give themselves at least 60 minutes or more to park, drop their child(ren) at the Stage Door, enter via the lobby doors, find their seats, etc. as the venue will be exceptionally busy at that time.

*How long is the show?*

The show is scheduled for 70 minutes with no intermission.

*Can we take pictures of the show with our cell phones, digital cameras or video cameras?*

No, video and photographs cannot be taken during the performance. Gloo Studios, a production company based here in the Heights, is filming both shows and Kidsandfamily.ca will be the official photographers. Both products will be provided to parents free-of-cost at a later date.

*Can I leave my cell phone on during the performance?*

All cell phones and electronic devices must be turned off during the performance.

*Where can I park my vehicle?*

You can park your vehicle in the parking lot at the northeast corner of the property (north of Norseman Park). Please do not park in the parking spots reserved for staff and VIPs between Centennial Theatre and Lonsdale Skate Park.

*How do we purchase tickets?*

Tickets are available for purchase through school cash online and in the community office until Thursday, February 22.

*How do I receive my tickets?*

All tickets will be sent home with students on Friday, February 23.
